# Dinosaurs

Finished Quilt- 52" x 64"

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurements on borders are approximate, measure your quilt top before cutting the length.

## Fabric Requirements

<b>Fabric A:</b> Red Dino Fossils: 2616-308	1/4 yard
<b>Fabric B:</b> Beige Dino Fossils: 2616-309	3/4 yard
<b>Fabric C:</b> Green Dino Fossils: 2616-303	1/3 yard
<b>Fabric D:</b> Red Dino Skin: 2616-208	1/4 yard
<b>Fabric E:</b> Green Dino Skin: 2616-203	3/4 yard
<b>Fabric F:</b> Blue Dino Skin: 2616-207	1/4 yard
<b>Fabric G:</b> Black Dino Dots: 2616-100	1-1/4 yards
<b>Fabric H:</b> Dino Stripe: 2616-500	2-1/4 yards
<b>Fabric I:</b> Dino Toss: 2616-408	3/4 yard
<b>Backing:</b> Your Choice	3-1/2 yards

## Cutting:

Cut six 4-1/2" squares and four 3-1/2" squares.  
 Cut six 6" squares, twenty-four 2-1/2" squares and twelve 4-7/8" squares.  
 Cut twelve 4-7/8" squares.  
 Cut three 6" squares.  
 Cut twenty-four 2-1/2" squares, four 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips, and four 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips. Cut two 2-1/2" x 37-1/2" and two 2-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips for Border #2.  
 Cut three 6" squares.  
 Cut twelve 4-7/8" squares, four 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips and four 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips. Cut two 1" x 36-1/2" and two 1" x 25-1/2" strips for Border #1. Cut six 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece them together to make two 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" and two 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips for the Inner Border. Cut six 2-1/4" x WOF strips for the binding.  
 Fussy cut two 7-1/2" x 41-1/2" and two 7-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips from the length of fabric, centering each on a dino stripe.  
 Cut six 4" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 4" x 57-1/2" and two 4" x 52-1/2" strips for Outer Border.  
 Cut and sew into one 60" x 72" for backing.

## Assembly Instructions:

- Place one 4-7/8" Fabric C square on top of one 4-7/8" Fabric G square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two C/G half-square triangles (Fig. 3). Repeat to make twenty-four C/G half-square triangles total.
- Place one 2-1/2" Fabric E square on the G corner of on C/G half-square triangle, right sides together (fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 5). Trim the excess fabric away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat with the remaining 2-1/2" Fabric E squares and C/G half-square triangles to make twenty-four Block Corners.
- Repeat Step 1 with three 6" Fabric B squares and three 6" Fabric D squares to make six B/D half-square triangles. Trim them to measure 4-7/8" square. Repeat Step 1 with three 6" Fabric B squares and three 6" Fabric F squares to make six B/F half-square triangles. Trim them to measure 4-7/8" square.
- Place one B/D half-square triangle from Step 2 on top of one 4-7/8" Fabric B square, right sides together (fig. 4). Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line (fig. 5). Cut on the drawn line to make two 4-1/2" Red Block side squares. Repeat with the remaining B/D half-square triangles to make twelve Red Block Side squares (fig. 6). Repeat with the six B/F half-square triangles and six 4-7/8" Fabric B squares to make twelve Blue Block Side squares.
- Using the flip and sew method in step 2, sew one 2-1/2" Fabric B square to each corner of one 4-1/2" Fabric A square to make one Block Center (fig. 9). Make six Block Centers total.
- Refer to the Block Layout and make six 12-1/2" blocks. Refer to the quilt photo and sew the blocks together to make the quilt top.
- Sew one 1" x 36-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1" x 25-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 2-1/2" x 37-1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 29-1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Refer to the quilt photo for direction and sew one 7-1/2" x 41-1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top.
- Refer to Figure 8 and sew together four pieced corners. Sew one pieced corner to each end of the two 7-1/2" x 29-1/2" Fabric H strip. Sew the pieced strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 4" x 57-1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4" x 52-1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

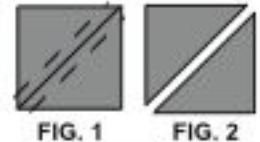

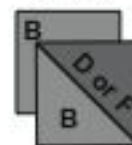

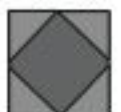
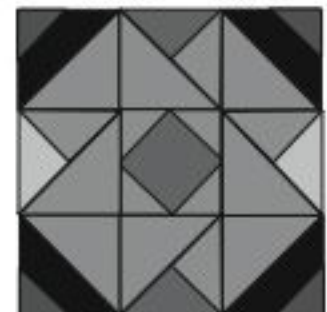
